- At least six of the eight ties feature first meetings between the sides.
- The potential exceptions (if Salzburg beat Frankfurt, otherwise it is seven out of eight!):
 - Rangers beat Leverkusen in the 1998/99 UEFA Cup second round (1-1 h, 2-1 a)
 - Basel beat Salzburg in the 2013/14 UEFA Europa League round of 16 (0-0 h, 2-1 a)

- Manchester United are unbeaten in their eight games against Austria clubs, winning seven.
- The Portuguese coaches of Olympiacos and Wolves, Pedro Martins and Nuno Espírito Santo, were team-mates at Guimarães in 1994/95.
- Wolves' Daniel Podence will face his former Olympiacos team-mates, having made the switch from Piraeus in January.

Partizan Belgrade away is probably the most attractive fixture; Construction of the Partizan stadium was started after World War II, on the site of **BSK Stadion**, which was a 25,000 seat stadium that hosted the Yugoslav national team as well as BSK Beograd. The stadium was built with the help of the Yugoslav People's Army, in the period between 1948 and 1951. In April 1989, Partizan Belgrade purchased the stadium from the former Yugoslav People's Army, and thus became the owner. The name of the stadium were officially changed in *Partizan Stadium*. Partizan stadium had a 50,000 capacity before the new UEFA security regulations came in effect. There were 15 924 seats, 33 000 standing places and 585 box seats.

It was renovated in 1998, and has had a capacity of 32,710 since. **Guide to Follow**

Astana Football Club is a professional football club based in Nur-Sultan. They play in the Kazakhstan Premier League, the highest level of Kazakh football. The club's home ground is the 30,254-seat Astana Arena stadium. **Guide to Follow**

Gdansk to host 2020 UEFA Europa League final

Opened in 2011, Arena Gdańsk hosted four games at UEFA EURO 2012 – three group stage fixtures and Germany's 4-2 quarter-final win against Greece – and is home to Ekstraklasa side Lechia Gdańsk. Poland have played a number of international friendlies at the stadium, but the ground has yet to hold a match in UEFA club competition.

Located in the city's Letnica neighbourhood, the stadium's curved 45,000 square-metre exterior consists of 18,000 plates designed to resemble amber, which has long been extracted along the Baltic coast.
